



Regulations of International Cave Maps Exhibition

Participants

- Participants refer to drafters of the map(s) submitted to the International cave map exhibition.
- Exhibition will be open for national and international participants. Each participant may submit no more than two cave maps.
- Invited participants are participants who are formally invited by the committee, or participants appointed by invited bodies.

Maps

- Digital copies of cave maps in pdf form, with maximum printed size of A1 (42 x 59.4 cm).
- The maps may be drafted manually, digitally, or by combination of both techniques.
- Participants may put logos of their organizations or institutions on the map.
- Whenever there are two or more maps of the same cave, made with same techniques, and show same informations, those maps can only be accepted if they have different date of surveying, otherwise the committee will not show those maps in the exhibition and will explain this matter to the related submitters.



Registration

- Registration form, along with the maps, can be submitted electronically to formulir.snf@gmail.com
- The name of the map's title on the registration form must be the same as the name of the attached file.
- Closing date of registration and submission is September 16th 2016.
- Participants are free of charge.

Copy right

- The drafter is considered to be the owner of the copyright of the map(s) submitted. Whenever the actual right belongs to a certain group, organization, or institution, then the participant is considered to have gained permission to represent those parties.
- Digital and hard copies of the exhibited maps belong to the organizer.
- Organizer will not share the digital and hard copies of the maps unless upon permission of the drafter.

Display of the maps

- The committee will facilitate 50 non contest maps to be printed and displayed during the exhibition event. If the committee shall receive more than 50 maps, the maps will have to go through some sort of selection process. The selection process will be done online by an appointed team. Maps submitted by invited participants will be printed and exhibited without going through this selection process.
- Along with each map exhibited on this event, will be a miniature of participant's national flag, and a brief note of participant's identity.
