in 2023 we will meet at the Urwelt-Museum Oberfranken, it is the regional museum for natural history and mineralogy in Upper Franconia.

Founded in 1833 as Kreis-Naturalien-Cabinet, reopened in 1998 as Urwelt-Museum Oberfranken.

The museum in the pedestrian zone of Bayreuth shows on 3 floors the history of the animate and inanimate nature of Upper Franconia by means of many fossils and minerals. The contents are made experiencable, also by numerous hands-on exhibits, for children, adults and professional audience.







Venue:

By plane: The closest airport to Bayreuth is Nuremberg Airport, from there take the U2 to Nuremberg Central Station, change there to the RE30/32 to Bayreuth.

By car: The Bayreuth region can be reached quickly and easily by car via the A9 motorway (Berlin - Bayreuth - Nuremberg - Munich), the A70 motorway in the direction of Bamberg - Frankfurt / Main and the B303 trunk road in the direction of Prague.

Abstracts may be written in English or German with a text length of maximum 3,000 characters including spaces. The texts should also contain the names, addresses, e-mails of all authors – please underline the author who will talk! All figures (photos, illustrations, diagrams, maps) should be provided as separate files (JPG, TIFF, PNG). Tables have to be submitted in separate MS Excel files. Texts should be provided unformatted in MS Word files.

The extended abstract could be published as a supplement to the reports of the Natural Science Society Bayreuth. The University of Bayreuth distributes the publications worldwide through an exchange of papers.
